Printed matter exempted from the prerequisite that the name of the printer and the address of his business be affixed on printed matter.

I, Daniel Pieter Antonie Schutte, Minister of Home Affairs, hereby, in terms of section 5 of the Imprint Act, 1993, exempt the following types of printed matter from the provisions of section 2 of the mentioned Act:

- (a) Commercial printed matter
  - (i) Labels, stamps and seals-smaller than 25 cm<sup>2</sup>.
  - (ii) Business cards-11 cm x 8 cm or smaller.
  - (iii) Letterheads-printed, embossed or foiled.
  - (iv) Envelopes.
  - (v) Bags-smaller than 17 cm x 11 cm in size.
  - (vi) Tape-sealing machine strips.
  - (vii) Bank notes printed by the South African Bank Note Printing Company (Pty) Ltd.
  - (viii) Fruit wrappers.
  - (ix) All bills, Acts, reports, documents, memoranda or minutes of Parliament or any Parliamentary committee that are printed by order of Parliament or any Parliamentary committee or the State President or the Speaker of the House.
  - (x) All circulars and work printed on a duplicating machine and published by and in the name of any state department or the Republic of South Africa.
- (b) Personal, professional and private stationery
  - (i) Notepaper-printed, embossed or foiled.
  - (ii) Envelopes.
  - (iii) Visiting Cards.
  - (iv) Invitation and acknowledgement cards.
  - (v) Wedding stationery.

## **IMPRINT REGULATIONS**

The Minister of Home Affairs has, in terms of section 6 of the Imprint Act, 1993 (Act No.43 of 1993), made the regulations in the Schedule.

### **SCHEDULE**

### **Definition**

- (1) In these regulations any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall, unless the context otherwise indicates, have that meaning, and the Act" shall mean the Imprint Act, 1993 (Act No.43 of 1993).
  - (2) Unless the context otherwise indicates. a reference in these regulations
    - (a) to a section by a specific number shall be interpreted as a reference to the section of that number in the Act; and
    - (b) to a prescribed form by a specific number shall be interpreted as a reference to the form of that number in the Schedule.

## Application for registration of imprint abbreviation

- 2 (1) An application referred to in section 3 (1) shall be in the form and contain substantially the information prescribed in Schedule 1.
  - (2) An application referred to in subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by the amount of R50.00.

## Fee payable for extract from register of imprint abbreviations

An application referred to in section 3(5) for a certified copy of particulars from the register of imprint abbreviations, shall be accompanied by the amount of R10,00.

## Notice of change of any particulars in an application for registration of an imprint abbreviation

- 4 (1) A notice referred to in section 3(6)(b) shall be in the form and contain substantially the information prescribed in Schedule 2.
  - (2) A notice referred to in subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by the amount of R25,00.

## **Short title**

5 These regulations shall be called the Imprint Regulations, 1993.
