Our Vision: A South Africa without hunger.

Our Mission: To reduce hunger in South Africa by safely and cost-effectively securing quality food, and making it available to those who need it.

One third of all the food produced in South Africa is wasted, while more than 14 million people go without adequate food to meet their basic needs.

Established in 2009 to address widespread hunger in South Africa, FoodForward SA connects a world of excess to a world of need by recovering edible surplus food from farmers, manufacturers, and retailers for redistribution to registered Beneficiary Organisations (BOs) that serve the poor. We call this cost-effective model Foodbanking.

FoodForward SA is part of a global movement focussed on alleviating hunger and reducing the environmental impact by diverting good quality edible surplus food.

Reducing food waste and loss is the third most effective solution for fighting climate change. For every ton of food recovered, 4 tons of greenhouse gas emissions are saved.

WAREHOUSING

Sourcing, collecting, sorting, and storing edible surplus food for distribution to BOs.

FOODSHARE

We virtually connect BOs to retail stores for the regular collection of surplus food using digital technology.

SECOND HARVEST

Recovering post-harvest surplus from farmers and growers.

MOBILE RURAL DEPOTS

We take monthly food provisions to BOs located in vulnerable rural communities.

FEEDING PROGRAMMES

In partnership with various corporates, we provide nutritious breakfast cereals and milk to 50,000 learners daily across the country.

YOUTH INTERNSHIP

FFSA offers a SETA accredited supply chain youth internship for unemployed youth.
