#### **COUNTRY REPORT:**

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS: Chicken meat production grew 4% compared with 2013 production. In 2015 it forecast a boost in the industry promoted by reinforcement of border control measures, the expected production is of 60.000 tons of national/domestic production.

CONSUMER CONSUMPTION TRENDS: The consumption has been increasing faster than the production is. Current estimated consumption per capita is of about 3Kg pppa.

CURRENT ISSUES AND CHALLENGES: Macroeconomics, with U\$dolar climbing from 32.00Mt in early 2015, now rated at 38.00Mt per 1U\$D, affecting raw materials imports costly one side, and on the other prices of frozen chicken cannot be increased considering fierce completion with imported frozen chicken.

The recently discovered dumping of SA Day Old Male layer chicks, also contributing to a slower growth of the domestic.

DISEASE: No major issues have been reported, the current animal health situation is stable.

ANIMAL HEALTH: The lack of a reference laboratory weakens the national vet services to be able to produce fast results.

TRADE DEVELOPMENTS: Increasing smuggling and dumping of brasil, Malawi and S.A frozen chickens threats the future of the Mozambique poultry industry.

### **COUNTRY REPORT:**

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS: Increasing contraband of table eggs through border with Malawi, Swaziland and South Africa, make impossible for the domestic industry to grow.

CONSUMER CONSUMPTION TRENDS: Consumption tends to grow, we estimate that 60% of the demand is supplied by smuggled table egg from the above mentioned neighboring countries.

CURRENT ISSUES AND CHALLENGES: Out of control of contraband of table egg into Mozambique.

DISEASE: No major issues have been reported.
